

A Committee has been formed to organise parish events to celebrate Her Majesty the Queen's Diamond Jubilee as follows:-

Church Service at St. Materiana's Parish Church, 6.00 p.m.

Monday 4th June – Family Disco (children up to 12 years of age) at the Social Hall,

6.30 p.m. – 9.00 p.m.

Please note families only, sorry but no unaccompanied children, thank you.

Monday 4th June - Jubilee Beacon at Glebe Cliff, Tintagel 10.00 – 10.30 p.m.

A Beacon event has been registered; however, this event is subject to approval awaited from Natural England and the National Trust.

If the application to site a beacon at Glebe Cliff is successful, we will be looking for material with which to build the beacon. We have had an offer for the use of a tractor and trailer from a local farmer to collect material and transport it to Glebe Cliff. If you feel you have any wood or other suitable material which could be used to build the beacon, please contact the Clerk as soon as possible, who will add your name to a list for collection on the day of the event. Please ONLY suitable material for burning – no general household rubbish etc. Are you able to help build the beacon or help as a marshall at the Beacon - if so please contact Sue Moth.

Tuesday 5th June from 1.00 p.m. – Fun afternoon/evening at the Memorial Playing Fields to include cake competition, fancy dress competitions, fun races, giant picnic, presentation of commemorative mugs and barbecue

Come along from 1.00 – 2.00 p.m. and set up your picnic area for later.

Refreshments (tea, coffee, squash etc.) will be available all afternoon. There will be limited parking available. Come along and join in with the events below. All very welcome!

1.30 p.m. Adults and Children's Decorated Victoria Sponge or cupcake(s) competition. There will be a competition for the best Jubilee themed decorated sponge or cupcake(s). Entries must be brought to the Cricket Club at 1.00 p.m. and no later than 1.30 p.m. when judging will take place. It would be appreciated if all cakes and cupcakes entered could be donated for use with refreshments through the afternoon's celebrations.
