TINTAGEL VISITOR CENTRE

The Visitor Centre re-opened on the 18th June with a willing band of volunteers. The response to the effort put in by the Parish Council has been great and as well as a constant stream of visitors coming through the doors, a large number of local people have called in to give their support too. Throughput is comparable with last year's figures.

The Centre has been restocked with the usual books, maps, guides and leaflets along with a selection of local products from businesses within the village complemented by selected lines from throughout Cornwall.

The response from local accommodation providers has been good, with many receiving their first referrals since the Centre closed in September.

Volunteers have come on board to offer their skills and are able to help in many ways from answering questions, operating the till, re-stocking shelves, restoring the telephone and internet service, cleaning and gardening outside. The rapport among them is great and provides a pleasant atmosphere in which to work.

There is no doubt that the venture taken on by the Parish Council will prove to be a huge success .

We still have slots available for anyone who is interested in volunteering, from a whole morning or afternoon or just for an hour or two when they can. May I thank the many people who gave their warmest support and encouragement in the arrangements towards the celebrations – and my efforts.

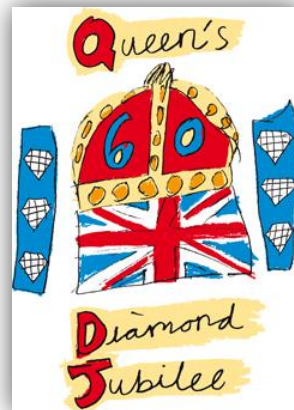
The remarkable Reg Climo, he spoke to every child, many he knew by name, each child clutching their commemorative mug with happy faces.

Tintagel Sea Angling Club Newsletter – Aug 2012

The first half of the year has been difficult fishing with catch rates well down on previous years. The weather has certainly played a part in it with the high rainfall in June affecting the estuary catches. Sea temperatures have slowly risen to 14⁰C, which is lower than normal for the time of the year as I write in early July. Let's hope that there is a vast improvement by the time this newsletter is published. The May fish of the month award was won by Garry Boyde with a Mackerel and June's fish of the month award was also won by Garry with a bass of 4lbs 8 ³/₄ Ozs. Congratulations go to club member Ian Young who secured third place in this year's Cornish Lure Festival with a bass of 58cms.

There has been much publicity about the porbeagle shark caught recently off Boscastle. Its estimated weight was 550lbs and was captured by Wayne Comben and Graeme Pullen. The fish took 90 minutes to reel in and dragged their 17' boat more than a mile. Had the fish been landed it would probably have been a new British record and the largest shark ever caught in British waters. Thankfully, it was tagged and released. The British Record Fish Committee has recognised it in the "Notable Fish List". The episode was captured on film and was aired on many news stations a You Tube video can be viewed here:

Over 808,000 people have now signed up to Hugh Fearnley-Whittingstall "Fish Fight" and the EU Council has finally agreed to end fish discards. However, the timing has not yet been agreed and with the EU dragging its heels the ban on discarding herring and mackerel is not likely until 2014. The ban on discarding other pressurised species such as haddock, plaice and cod might not come fully in to force until 2018. Let's hope that

the million tonnes of annually discarded fish is sustainable until then. For further details, please visit the website <http://www.fishfight.net/>

First prize will be £200, second prize £100 and third prize £50 there will also be rods and reels to be won for various specie prizes. You can sign on at the Wootons Hotel, Tintagel, St Columb roundabout, Padstow Angling Centre, the Olde Forge Fish shop at Wadebridge. The sign on time is from 5 – 5.30pm on Saturday 15th September. The weigh in will be held at the Wootons Hotel, Tintagel from 6.30 – 7pm on Sunday 16th September. Entry fee is only £5 for seniors and £3 for juniors and anyone can enter, you do not need to be a club member.

The big tides in August are on the 3rd with the full moon on the 2nd and the new moon on the 17th where sunrise will be at 6.14 & sunset at 20.33

In September the big tides are on the 17th & 18th and the full moon is on the 30th the new moon is on the 16th when sunrise will be at 6.56 & sunset at 19.33

The next general meeting will be held on Tuesday 7th August at the Wootons Hotel at 7.30pm.

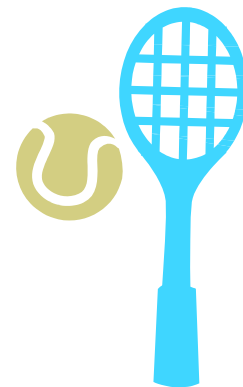

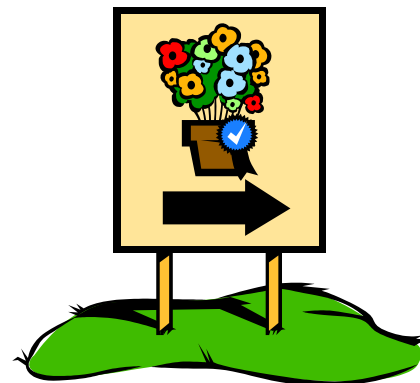
TINTAGEL FIRST RESPONDERS

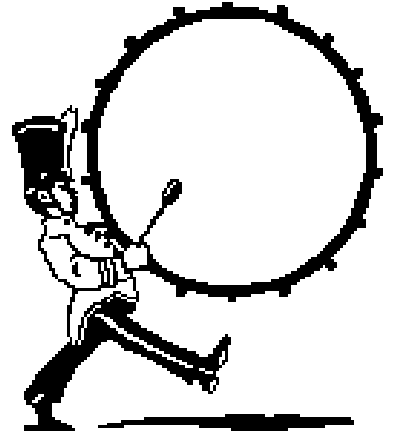
You may have spotted the odd notice in the parish notice cabinets stating that our councillor monthly surgery at the One Stop Shop has been discontinued as from the end of June.
